

Fair Share Dues Formula



Membership dues are calculated based on a fair share formula and vary by industry type. The company/firm is the Chamber member, not a particular individual. **The base dues of \$295 include the annual membership investment. There is an additional administrative fee of \$25 for all new memberships.** Membership is for 12 months and the company/firm will be invoiced thirty (30) days prior to the anniversary date. Membership dues may be tax-deductible as a business expense; discuss this with your tax advisor. Membership dues may be paid for by cash, check, MasterCard/VISA or American Express.

Tour Companies	base + \$6 per employee or base + per van charge as follows 1-10 seats - \$55 each van 11-20 seats - \$85 each van 21 & over - \$95 each van
Transportation and Port	base + \$6 per employee
Utilities	negotiable
Wholesaler/Distributor	base + \$8 per employee

Calculating the Investment – An Example:

Identify the base dues amount from the schedule, based on the number of employees and industry and add in any additional charges listed on the schedule. For a company with additional fees above and beyond the base, add the extra fees, the base and the administrative fee to determine the total amount due.

Example: If a service firm has 13 employees, the base dues would be \$295 *plus* \$78 (\$6 x 13 employees), for a total of \$373. The \$25 enrollment processing fee would be added to this dues amount for a total amount due of \$398.

Processing Fee

All new members pay a one-time application-processing fee of \$25.
