The U.S. Chamber's Institute for Legal Reform (ILR) released the findings of its National COVID-19 Liability Survey which revealed that Americans across the political spectrum believe that employers must have protections from COVID-related lawsuits as they make decisions about how to safely and sustainably reopen their businesses. Among other key findings, the survey shows that more than six in ten Americans say that Congress should extend liability protections to employers from lawsuits related to the coronavirus.
