## Vote Yes on SPLOST November 5

The Chamber board feels SPLOST, Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax, is a financially wise way to generate capital funds, since **visitors to our community contribute upwards of 40 percent of our sales tax collections.** Without SPLOST, a substantial increase in property taxes is the most likely alternative.

On November 5, voters in Chatham County will be asked to endorse a new \$400 million six-year SPLOST that will allow our local governments the continued ability to address the expensive capital needs of the community.

For the past 34 years, Chatham County has benefited from more than \$1.8 billion in infrastructure and capital projects thanks to SPLOST.

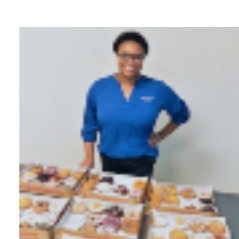

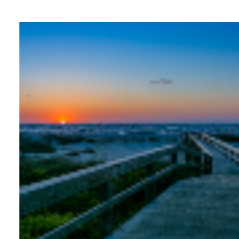
### Group Tour & Entertainment Manager Hosts Film Executives

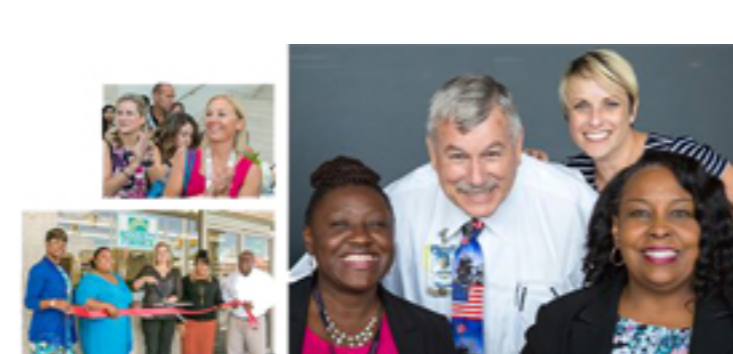
